## RULES OF THE DOJANG

- Remove all shoes before entering the training area.
- Proper attire is to be worn while inside of the training area.
- Bow as you enter and leave the training area.
- Bow and exchange greetings with the instructor and senior students when entering and leaving the training area.
- When you arrive late to class, do not join the class until the instructor gives you permission to do so.
- When you need to be excused early from class, you must receive permission from the instructor before the class begins.
- Inform the instructor of all injuries and conditions that may affect your training before the class begins.

- Do not wear jewelry of any kind inside of the training area.
- Eating, drinking, and gum chewing inside of the training area are forbidden.
- Idle chatter and horseplay inside of the training area are forbidden.
- Smoking is prohibited.
- The phone can only be used by students for emergencies.
- No crying in the DO-JANG.

### Verse of the Week

#### IS IT REALLY OF GOD?

*"Test the spirits to see whether they are from God"*  
1 John 4:1

God's leadings are ALWAYS consistent with His Word. He will never lead you to be unfaithful to your marriage partner, cheat on an examination, exaggerate to a customer, spread hurtful gossip, deceive your parents or your children, or do anything else forbidden by Scripture. His leadings will always be consistent with the person He meant you to be. For example: if you love mathematics and are naturally gifted with computers, why would you assume that God would lead you into music? Or if you are not comfortable around children, why would you figure He would lead you to become a school teacher? Get real! God's leadings do not contradict who He made you to be. He does not create you with particular gifts, and then expect you to excel at something totally unrelated.

If you sense a leading that seems contrary to what God made you to be, test it carefully. Is God asking you to do this because at present there is no one else to do it? Is He stretching you into new areas so that your faith will grow? Or is this not 'a God idea' at all, but rather a distraction from the assignment He has already given you? This is why John writes, *'Dear friends, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God.'*
